Day 1. Arrival (July 5, 2022) Tuesday




Day 5. Pittsburgh (July 9, 2022) Saturday

Early in the morning, we left Clifton House for the Kentucky airport from which we flew to Washington D.C. We had the opportunity to see the sights of the capital city of the United States Capitol and the Washington Monument from the air.

The next flight took us to our final destination, Pittsburgh.

There we were warmly welcomed by a professor from Carlow University, prof. Enrique Mu, Ph.D. To begin with, the professor took us to a hill above the city to show us Pittsburgh from afar. We had lunch together and talked about our studies and cooperation. After lunch, the professor took us to the Carnegie Museum of Natural History, a natural history museum in Pittsburgh.

The guests liked our presentations, and the students of Carlow University also had interesting research topics. The event was also attended by a member of the Croatian Fraternal Union Ivan Begg, editor-in-chief of the newspaper "Zajedničar".
